Project Goals

An attempt to produce a forum system similar to CSU Forums To investigate emerging technologies: Java 2 Enterprise Edition Enterprise Java Beans XML, SOAP (Simple Object Access) Protocol), DOM, SAX, JDOM Visual Basic DLLs, XML Parsing techniques

Summary of the current system

CSU Forums is a traditional forum system developed in house by CSU.
It only has a web based interface to the central server database that contains the messages.

FreeForums features

 Web based interface to central server allowing users to post, view and reply to messages.

 Traditional GUI for the Microsoft Windows Platform which can be used as a substitute to the Web client.

Software deliverables

- Java 2 Enterprise Edition components containing the business logic of the system.
- A web based interface written using Java Servlets and Java Server Pages
- A Microsoft Windows compatible Desktop GUI client, written using Visual Basic 6
